1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Sewage Sludge Storage Facilities - Permit to Install, Alter, or Extend -**
3 **Issuance**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Department of the Environment from issuing a
5 permit to install, materially alter, or materially extend a sewage sludge storage
6 facility until the facility meets certain zoning and land use requirements; and
7 generally relating to the issuance of a permit to install, materially alter, or
8 materially extend a sewage sludge storage facility.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Environment**

17 9-233.

18 The Department may not issue a permit to install, materially alter, or
19 materially extend a sewage sludge composting facility OR A SEWAGE SLUDGE
20 STORAGE FACILITY until:

1 (1) The sewage sludge composting facility OR SEWAGE SLUDGE STORAGE
2 FACILITY meets all zoning and land use requirements of the county where the sewage
3 sludge composting OR STORAGE facility is to be located; and

4 (2) [The] IN THE CASE OF A SEWAGE SLUDGE COMPOSTING FACILITY,
5 THE Department has a written statement that the board of county commissioners or
6 the county council of the county where the sewage sludge composting facility is to be
7 located does not oppose the issuance of the permit.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 ~~October~~ July 1, 1999.
