A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Barbers**

3 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Barbers in accordance with the  
4 provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (Sunset Law) by extending  
5 to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and  
6 regulatory authority of the Board; and generally relating to the State Board of  
7 Barbers.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article - Business Occupations and Professions  
10 Section 4-702  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (1995 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions**

16 4-702.

17 Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland  
18 Program Evaluation Act, this title and all regulations adopted under this title shall  
19 terminate and be of no effect after [July 1, 2001] JULY 1, 2011.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
21 October 1, 1999.
