- 15 (d) (1) The Department shall develop procedures to coordinate the statewide
- 16 availability of textbooks and supplementary instructional materials in nonvisually

- 18 (2) THE STATE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO REQUIRE A
- 19 PUBLISHER OF A TEXTBOOK, INCLUDING TEXTS IN ELECTRONIC MEDIA ADOPTED BY
- 20 A COUNTY BOARD TO FURNISH THE INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCE CENTER
- 21 ESTABLISHED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION WITH AN ELECTRONIC
- 22 VERSION OF THE MATERIAL IN WHICH THE CONTENT:

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1999.
