- 8 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 9 INDICATED.

- 1 (2) ANY NOTICE REQUIRED BY LAW TO BE SERVED BY PERSONAL
- 2 SERVICE ON A RESIDENT AGENT OR OTHER AGENT OR OFFICER OF A STATE AGENCY
- 3 MAY BE SERVED IN THE MANNER PROVIDED BY THE MARYLAND RULES RELATING TO
- 4 SERVICE OF PROCESS ON STATE AGENCIES.
- 5 (3) SERVICE UNDER THE MARYLAND RULES IS EQUIVALENT TO
- 6 PERSONAL SERVICE ON A RESIDENT AGENT OR OTHER AGENT OR OFFICER OF A
- 7 STATE AGENCY.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act does not affect a
- 9 designation, change, or resignation of a resident agent or a change of address for a
- 10 resident agent that may be on file with the Department of Assessments and Taxation
- 11 on the effective date of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 January 1, 2000.
