- 36 limited partnership, limited liability partnership, or limited liability company, or any
- 37 other person [binds] CONSTITUTES EFFECTIVE SERVICE OF PROCESS UNDER
- 38 MARYLAND RULES ON the corporation, partnership, limited partnership, limited

- 1 liability partnership, or limited liability company, or other person in any action, suit,
- 2 or proceeding which is pending, filed, or instituted against it under the provisions of
- 3 this article.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act does not affect a
- 5 designation, change, or resignation of a resident agent or a change of address for a
- 6 resident agent that may be on file with the Department of Assessments and Taxation
- 7 on the effective date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 9 January 1, 2000.
