- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article 27 Crimes and Punishments

- 16 (A) THIS SECTION ONLY APPLIES TO PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.
- 17 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT OPERATE A PLACE OF PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT
- 18 WITHIN 500 FEET OF A RESIDENTIAL DWELLING UNIT WHERE THE ENTERTAINMENT
- 19 IS OF THE TYPE LISTED IN ARTICLE 2B, § 10-405(C) THROUGH (F) OF THE CODE.
- 20 (C) AN OWNER, LESSEE, OR MANAGER OF ANY PLACE OF PUBLIC
- 21 ENTERTAINMENT WHO KNOWINGLY PERMITS THE SAME TO BE USED FOR
- 22 ENTERTAINMENT OF THE TYPE LISTED IN ARTICLE 2B, § 10-405(C) THROUGH (F) OF
- 23 THE CODE OR WHO ASSENTS TO ITS USE FOR ANY SUCH PURPOSE IN VIOLATION OF
- 24 THIS SECTION SHALL BE GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION MAY BE
- 25 FINED UP TO \$5,000 OR IMPRISONED FOR UP TO 1 YEAR OR BOTH.
- 26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 27 October 1, 1999.
