A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Damages for Injury to or Death of Pet Animal**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the measure of damages for tortious injuries to a pet  
4 animal; clarifying that certain damages may be recovered for the tortious death  
5 of a pet animal; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating  
6 to damages for tortious injury to or death of a pet animal.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

15 11-110.

16 (a) (1) In this section "pet" means a domesticated animal.

17 (2) "Pet" does not include livestock.

18 (b) The measure of damages for tortious injuries to OR DEATH OF a pet is THE  
19 GREATER OF:

20 (1) the market value of the pet before the injury OR DEATH [or]; OR

21 (2) the [reasonable] ACTUAL cost of veterinary care [, but not more than  
22 \$2,500 if such charge is greater].

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be  
24 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect  
25 on or application to a cause of action arising before the effective date of this Act.

1 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
2 October 1, 1999.
