- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**
- 15 11-110.
- In this section "pet" means a domesticated animal. 16 (a) (1)
- 17 (2) "Pet" does not include livestock.
- The measure of damages for tortious injuries to OR DEATH OF a pet is THE 18 (b)
- 19 GREATER OF:
- 20 the market value of the pet before the injury OR DEATH [or]; OR (1)
- the [reasonable] ACTUAL cost of veterinary care [, but not more than 21
- 22 \$2,500 if such charge is greater].
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 24 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
- 25 on or application to a cause of action arising before the effective date of this Act.

- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1999.
