- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 (a) Except for benefits subject to an offset under § 29-118 of the State
- 16 Personnel and Pensions Article, if a statute, charter, ordinance, resolution,
- 17 regulation, or policy, regardless of whether part of a pension system, provides a
- 18 benefit to a covered employee of a governmental unit or a quasi-public corporation
- 19 that is subject to this title under § 9-201(2) of this title or, in case of death, to the
- 20 dependents of the covered employee, payment of the benefit by the employer satisfies,
- 21 to the extent of the payment, the liability of the employer and the subsequent injury
- 22 fund for payment of SIMILAR benefits under this title.
- 23 (2) If a benefit paid under paragraph (1) of this subsection is less than
- 24 the benefits provided under this title, the employer, the Subsequent Injury Fund, or
- 25 both shall provide an additional benefit that equals the difference between the benefit
- 26 paid under paragraph (1) of this subsection and the benefits provided under this title.
