- 2 Creation of a State Debt Allegany County Agricultural Expo and Fairgrounds
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$450,000,
- 5 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of County Commissioners of
- 6 Allegany County for certain development or improvement purposes; providing
- 7 for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee
- 8 provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for the issuance
- 9 and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.
- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That:
- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Allegany
- 14 County Agricultural Expo and Fairgrounds Loan of 1999 in a total principal amount
- 15 equal to the lesser of (i) \$450,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in
- 16 accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale,
- 17 and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board
- 18 of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through
- 19 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 20 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as 21 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 22 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 23 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 24 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 25 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 26 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 27 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 28 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of County Commissioners of
- 29 Allegany County (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the planning,
- 30 design, construction, and capital equipping of the Allegany County fairgrounds of
- 31 three connected pavilion buildings that would contain the Allegany County
- 32 Agricultural Expo offices, exhibition areas, rest rooms, and showers and a separate

- 1 expo building that would contain a year-round activity area with a catering kitchen
- 2 and rest rooms that could be used for meetings, conventions, banquets, trade shows,
- 3 and similar events.
- 4 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 5 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 6 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 7 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 8 (5) (a) The grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund.
- 9 (b) No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 10 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 11 unappropriated. The fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds
- 12 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount
- 13 of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the
- 14 Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final.
- 15 (c) The grantee shall present evidence to the satisfaction of the Board of
- 16 Public Works of the provision and expenditure of the matching fund, and the Board of
- 17 Public Works shall disburse the proceeds of the grant under the provisions of this Act
- 18 for the purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, both to be done in installments.
- 19 (d) As the grantee provides and expends an installment of the matching
- 20 fund, the Board of Public Works shall disburse an installment of the proceeds of the
- 21 grant equal to the portion of the matching fund presented at that time by the grantee.
- 22 (e) This method of presentation of the matching fund in installments and
- 23 of the disbursement of the proceeds of the loan in installments that are equal to each
- 24 presentation of the matching fund shall continue until the first to occur of the
- 25 disbursement of the total amount of the grant or June 1, 2001.
- 26 (f) The grantee has until June 1, 2001, to present the final evidence
- 27 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that the total matching fund will be
- 28 provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact, the
- 29 amount of the final installment of the matching fund, and the amount of the total
- 30 matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the final proceeds of the loan equal to the
- 31 final installment of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in
- 32 this Act. After June 1, 2001, any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the
- 33 matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no
- 34 further effect.
- 35 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 36 June 1, 1999.
