1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City - 45th District - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the issuance in, ~~or transfer into,~~ the 45th alcoholic
4 beverages district of Baltimore City of an alcoholic beverages license;
5 prohibiting, with a certain exception, the transfer of an alcoholic beverages
6 license into the 45th alcoholic beverages district of Baltimore City; and generally
7 relating to alcoholic beverages in the 45th alcoholic beverages district of
8 Baltimore City.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

2 9-204.1.

3 (a) New licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages may not be issued in:

4 (1) The 11th through 21st precincts of the 25th ward of Baltimore City.
5 This area includes the following communities:

6 Brooklyn

7 Cherry Hill

8 Curtis Bay

9 Fairfield

10 Hawkin's Point

11 Wagner's Point

12 (2) The 1st through 4th precincts and the 19th through 25th precincts of
13 the 13th ward of Baltimore City. This area includes the communities of Hampden and
14 Medfield.

15 (3) The 10th, 11th, 15th, 16th, 17th, 21st, 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 26th, 27th,
16 34th, 35th, and 36th precincts of the 27th ward of Baltimore City. This area includes
17 the community of Hamilton.

18 (4) The 46th alcoholic beverages district of Baltimore City consisting of:

19 Baltimore City wards 1 and 2;

20 Ward 3, precinct 3 and part of precinct 1;

21 Ward 6, precincts 1, 6, and 7;

22 Ward 7, precincts 8 and 9; and

23 Ward 26, precincts 1 through 33 and 47 through 51.

24 (5) The following areas of Baltimore City: the 5th and 7th precincts of
25 the 12th ward; the 6th through the 18th precincts of the 13th ward; the 10th, and
26 17th through the 24th, the 26th and 27th, the 31st through the 42nd, and the 44th
27 and 45th precincts of the 15th ward; the 6th and 7th precincts of the 16th ward; and
28 the 92nd through the 99th precincts of the 27th ward.

29 (6) The Pen Lucy precincts which include:

30 (i) Ward 9, precincts 1 and 2; and

1 (ii) Ward 27, precincts 52 and 53.

2 (7) The 41st alcoholic beverages district which consists of the following
3 areas in Baltimore City:

4 (i) Ward 15, precincts 1 through 9, inclusive, 11 through 16,
5 inclusive, and 43;

6 (ii) Ward 16, precincts 5 and 8 through 12, inclusive;

7 (iii) Ward 20, precincts 4 through 14, inclusive; and

8 (iv) Ward 28, precincts 4, 5, 6, 10, 11, 12, and 17.

9 (8) The 39th alcoholic beverages district, as defined in subsection (d) of
10 this section, except for the following areas:

11 (i) Ward 4, precincts 1 and 2;

12 (ii) The portion of ward 21, precinct 1 east of Greene Street;

13 (iii) The portion of ward 22, precinct 1 west of South Howard Street;

14 (iv) The portion of ward 22, precinct 1, bounded by Conway Street
15 running east from South Howard Street to South Charles Street; South Charles
16 Street running south from that point to Hughes Street; Hughes Street running east
17 from that point into Key Highway; Key Highway running from that point east and
18 then south to the precinct boundary; the precinct boundary running from that point
19 east to the harbor shoreline, then generally north along the shoreline, northwest from
20 the shoreline to Pratt Street, and then west along Pratt Street to South Howard
21 Street; and south along Howard Street from that point to Conway Street;

22 (v) The portion of ward 11, precincts 6 and 9, bounded by Centre
23 Street on the north, Guilford Avenue on the east, the southern boundary of ward 11 on
24 the south, and Eutaw Street on the west; and

25 (vi) The portion of ward 17, precinct 1, south of West Franklin
26 Street.

27 (9) For Class B licenses only, in the areas of the 47th alcoholic beverages
28 district covered by:

29 (i) The Key Highway East Industrial Area Urban Renewal Plan, as
30 adopted by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City in Ordinance 986 on June
31 29, 1987; and

32 (ii) The Key Highway Urban Renewal Plan, as adopted by the
33 Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City in Ordinance 622 on March 12, 1986.

34 (10) The 47th alcoholic beverages district, as defined in subsection (g) of
35 this section, except for the portion of ward 21, precinct 3, bounded on the southwest

1 by Gwynn Falls to the B&O Railroad; running northeast along the B&O Railroad to
2 Bayard Street; running from that point east along Bayard Street to Washington
3 Boulevard; and south along Washington Boulevard from that point to Gwynn Falls.

4 (11) THE 45TH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES DISTRICT OF BALTIMORE CITY.

5 (b) ~~Licenses~~ (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
6 SUBSECTION, LICENSES for the sale of alcoholic beverages of any class may not be
7 transferred into the areas of Baltimore City covered by this section.

8 (2) A LICENSED DRUGSTORE MAY TRANSFER THE LICENSE INTO THE
9 45TH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES DISTRICT OF BALTIMORE CITY.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 1999.
