SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

1 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions** 2 19-402. 3 (a) To qualify for certification as a security guard, an individual shall: 4 (1) meet the standards set by the Secretary; 5 (2) be an employee of or an applicant for employment with a licensed 6 security guard agency; 7 (3) BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER AND REPUTATION; 8 [(3)](4) submit to the licensed security guard agency, for forwarding to 9 the Secretary: 10 (i) a sworn application on the form the Secretary provides; 11 (ii) two sets of fingerprint cards marked with the applicant's 12 fingerprints; and 13 (iii) a nonrefundable application fee of \$15; and pay to the licensed security guard agency, for forwarding to the 14 [(4)](5) 15 Secretary, the cost of the fingerprint card record checks. On receipt from an applicant for certification as a security guard, a 17 licensed security guard agency shall forward to the Secretary the applicant's 18 application form, fingerprint cards, and records fee. 19 19-404.1. 20 BY REGULATION, THE SECRETARY SHALL STAGGER THE TERMS OF THE (A) 21 CERTIFICATIONS. 22 (B) UNLESS A CERTIFICATION IS RENEWED FOR A 3-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED 23 IN THIS SECTION, THE CERTIFICATION EXPIRES ON THE DATE THE SECRETARY SETS.
