FOR the purpose of defining the term "registration card" for certain provisions of law eoncerning carrying and displaying a registration card, to include a valid vehicle rental agreement under certain circumstances allowing the use of a rental agreement in place of a registration card in certain situations involving rental vehicles to satisfy certain requirements under the Maryland Vehicle Law pertaining to possession and display of registration cards; and generally relating to registration cards for rental vehicles.

5 6	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
7	Article - Transportation

9 10	(a) IN THIS SECTION, "REGISTRATION CARD" INCLUDES A VALID RENTAL  AGREEMENT IN THE CASE OF A RENTAL VEHICLE THAT:
11 12	(1) IS RENTED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 18 OF THIS ARTICLE;
13	3 (2) IS REGISTERED IN ANOTHER STATE.
14 15	An individual who is driving or in control of a vehicle shall carry a registration card in the vehicle to which the registration card refers.
	On demand of a police officer who identifies himself as a police officer, an individual who is driving or in control of a vehicle shall display a registration card that refers to the vehicle.
	(C) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY SATISFY SUBSECTION (A) OR (B) OF THIS SECTION BY CARRYING IN THE VEHICLE AND MAKING AVAILABLE A VALID RENTAL AGREEMENT IN PLACE OF A REGISTRATION CARD IN THE CASE OF A RENTAL VEHICLE THAT IS:
22	(1) RENTED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 18 OF THIS ARTICLE; OR
23 24	3 (2) RENTED OR LEASED FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING 180 DAYS AND REGISTERED IN ANOTHER STATE.

In this title, "rent" means to rent or lease for a period not exceeding 180 days.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
