5 City that food sales in certain restaurants must be a certain percentage of total
6 daily receipts; requiring certain Class B beer, wine and liquor licensees to file
7 annually with the Board of License Commissioners certain documents showing
8 that the food sales requirement is met; and generally relating to alcoholic
9 beverages licenses in the 47th Alcoholic Beverages District of Baltimore City.
