SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 (a) "Type I school vehicle" means a school vehicle that:
16 (1) Is designed and constructed to carry passengers;
17 (2) Is either of the body-on-chassis type construction or integral type 18 construction; and
19 (3) Has a gross vehicle weight of more than [10,000] 15,000 pounds and 20 provides a minimum of 13 inches of seating space per passenger.

- 1 (b) "Type I school vehicle" does not include any bus operated by a common 2 carrier under the jurisdiction of a State, regional, or federal regulatory agency or 3 operated by the agency itself.

- 5 "Type II school vehicle" means a school vehicle that:
- 6 (1) Is designed and constructed to carry passengers;
- 7 (2) Is either of the body-on-chassis type construction or integral type 8 construction; and
- 9 (3) Has a gross vehicle weight of [10,000] 15,000 pounds or less and 10 provides a minimum of 13 inches of seating space per passenger.
