15 16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

34 35	(C) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF RECKLESS DRIVING UNDER § 21-901.1(A) OF THIS ARTICLE AND ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS, BASED ON OFFENSES ALLEGED TO HAVE BEEN COMMITTED AT THE SAME TIME OR ARISING OUT OF CIRCUMSTANCES SIMULTANEOUS IN TIME AND PLACE:

- 28 (a) A person is guilty of reckless driving if [he] THE PERSON drives a motor

- 30 (1) In wanton or willful disregard for the safety of persons or property; or

- 1 (2) In a manner that indicates a wanton or willful disregard for the 2 safety of persons or property.
- 3 (b) A person is guilty of negligent driving if [he] THE PERSON drives a motor 4 vehicle in a careless or imprudent manner that endangers any property or the life or
- 5 person of any individual.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
