- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 **Article - Labor and Employment**
- 18 9-509.
- IF A COVERED EMPLOYEE OF A SUBCONTRACTOR THAT HAS SECURED 19
- 20 COMPENSATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS TITLE IS INJURED OR KILLED AS THE
- 21 RESULT OF THE NEGLIGENCE OF A PRINCIPAL CONTRACTOR OR ANOTHER
- 22 SUBCONTRACTOR OF A PRINCIPAL CONTRACTOR, THEN THE COVERED EMPLOYEE,
- 23 OR IN THE CASE OF DEATH, THE PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE, SURVIVING SPOUSE,
- 24 CHILD, OR DEPENDENT OF THE COVERED EMPLOYEE, WITH RESPECT TO THE
- 25 PRINCIPAL CONTRACTOR OR THE OTHER SUBCONTRACTOR, MAY:
- 26 (1) BRING A CLAIM FOR COMPENSATION UNDER THIS TITLE; OR
- 27 (2) BRING AN ACTION FOR DAMAGES.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1999.
