4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Caroline County Board of Education ~~and the~~  
5 ~~Caroline County Superintendent of Schools to provide, on request, certain~~  
6 ~~information to the Caroline County Board of County Commissioners; and~~  
7 ~~specifying the type of information to be provided~~ certain information about  
8 certain program implications with the annual budget when requested by the  
9 Caroline County Board of County Commissioners; providing for the termination  
10 of this Act; and generally relating to program implications of the education  
11 budget of Caroline County.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article - Education**

4 5-101.

5 (G) IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION,  
6 THE CAROLINE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION, UPON REQUEST BY THE CAROLINE  
7 COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, SHALL PROVIDE WITH THE ANNUAL  
8 BUDGET THE PROGRAM IMPLICATIONS OF RECOMMENDATIONS FOR REDUCTIONS TO  
9 OR INCREASES IN ITS ANNUAL BUDGET, AT WHATEVER DIFFERENT LEVELS OF  
10 FUNDING AND ACCOMPANIED BY WHATEVER REASONABLE SUPPORTING ~~DETAILS~~  
11 DETAIL AND ANALYSIS AS MAY BE SPECIFIED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
12 COMMISSIONERS. ~~PRIOR TO THE SUBMISSION OF THE ANNUAL BUDGET, SIMILAR~~  
13 ~~INFORMATION SHALL BE SUBMITTED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS UPON~~  
14 ~~REQUEST BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.~~

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
16 October 1, 1999. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of  
17 September 30, 2001, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act  
18 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
