1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Dorchester County - Power Dredging for Oysters**

- 3 FOR the purpose of allowing a person to power dredge oysters in waters contiguous to
- 4 Dorchester County if the person holds a certain license issued by the
- 5 Department of Natural Resources; authorizing the Department to issue certain
- 6 licenses and the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources to adopt
- 7 certain regulations relating to power dredging of oysters; requiring the
- 8 Secretary to adopt certain regulations regarding a certain oyster sanctuary;
- 9 limiting the season when a licensee can power dredge oysters under this Act;
- placing certain restrictions on the power dredging of oysters; and generally
- relating to the power dredging of oysters in waters contiguous to Dorchester

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article Natural Resources
- 21 4-1014.1.
- 22 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO THE WATERS OF THE STATE THAT LIE
- 23 CONTIGUOUS TO DORCHESTER COUNTY IN THE CHESAPEAKE BAY.
- 24 (B) A PERSON SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE DEPARTMENT BEFORE THE
- 25 PERSON MAY CATCH OYSTERS WITH A POWER DREDGE IN THE WATERS OF THE
- 26 STATE THAT LIE CONTIGUOUS TO DORCHESTER COUNTY IN THE CHESAPEAKE BAY,
- 27 EXCEPT FOR A PERSON HOLDING A VALID LICENSE TO CATCH OYSTERS BY DREDGE
- 28 BOAT LICENSE AND DREDGING FOR OYSTERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 4-1013 OF THIS
- 29 SUBTITLE.

- $1 \quad (C) \quad (1) \quad A$ PERSON MAY NOT HOLD AN OYSTER HARVESTER LICENSE AND A 2 POWER DREDGE LICENSE SIMULTANEOUSLY.
- 3 (2) THE DEPARTMENT:
- 4 (I) MAY ISSUE A POWER DREDGE LICENSE ONLY TO THE HOLDER 5 OF AN OYSTER HARVESTER LICENSE; AND
- 6 (II) SHALL SUSPEND A PERSON'S OYSTER HARVESTER LICENSE ON
- 7 ISSUANCE OF A POWER DREDGE LICENSE UNTIL THE TIME THE HOLDER
- 8 SURRENDERS THE POWER DREDGE LICENSE TO THE DEPARTMENT.
- 9 (3) (I) IF A PERSON WANTS TO REOBTAIN THE PERSON'S PREVIOUSLY
- 10 VALID OYSTER HARVESTER LICENSE, THE PERSON SHALL RETURN THE PERSON'S
- 11 CURRENTLY VALID POWER DREDGING LICENSE TO THE DEPARTMENT.
- 12 (II) UPON RECEIPT OF THE POWER DREDGING LICENSE, THE
- 13 DEPARTMENT SHALL EXCHANGE, AT NO COST, THE POWER DREDGING LICENSE FOR
- 14 THE PERSON'S FORMER, CURRENTLY VALID OYSTER LICENSE.
- 15 (D) A PERSON MAY CATCH OYSTERS BY POWER DREDGING ONLY DURING THE
- 16 POWER DREDGING SEASON. THE POWER DREDGING SEASON FOR OYSTERS SHALL
- 17 RUN FROM NOVEMBER 1 TO MARCH 15 IN THE WATERS OF THE STATE THAT LIE
- 18 CONTIGUOUS TO DORCHESTER COUNTY, BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHERNMOST POINT
- 19 OF LAND AT PRY ISLAND, THEN RUNNING COTERMINOUS WITH THE CRAB POT LINE
- 20 TO THE SOUTHERNMOST POINT OF LAND AT JAMES ISLAND, THEN TO THE LIGHTED
- 21 BUOY AT KENWOOD BEACH, AT LATITUDE 38 DEGREES 30 MINUTES, THEN TO THE
- 22 POINT OF BEGINNING.
- 23 (E) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF § 4-1008(A) OF THIS
- 24 SUBTITLE, A PERSON MAY NOT CATCH OYSTERS WITH A POWER DREDGING LICENSE:
- 25 (I) ON SATURDAY OR SUNDAY; OR
- 26 (II) BEFORE SUNRISE OR AFTER 3:00 P.M. ON ANY DAY MONDAY
- 27 THROUGH FRIDAY.
- 28 (2) IN ADDITION TO THE PROVISIONS OF § 4-1013(E) AND (F) OF THIS
- 29 SUBTITLE, A PERSON WHO HAS A POWER DREDGING LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION:
- 30 (I) HAS A LIMIT OF 12 BUSHELS FOR EACH PERSON OR 24 BUSHELS
- 31 PER BOAT, WITH A LIMIT OF TWO LICENSED POWER DREDGERS PER BOAT; AND
- 32 (II) MAY USE ONLY A POWER DREDGE BAR THAT HAS A MINIMUM
- 33 SIZE OF 36 INCHES UP TO A MAXIMUM SIZE OF 42 INCHES.
- 34 (F) (1) THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE
- 35 INTENT OF THIS SECTION.

- 1 (2) THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE SECRETARY MAY VARY THE 2 LIMITS ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (E)(2)(I) OF THIS SECTION.
- 3 (3) (I) THE REGULATIONS SHALL ESTABLISH AN OYSTER SANCTUARY
- 4 CONSISTING OF NOT LESS THAN 100 ACRES WITHIN THE AREA DESCRIBED IN
- 5 SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION.
- 6 (II) A PERSON MAY NOT CATCH OYSTERS IN THE OYSTER
- 7 SANCTUARY DESCRIBED IN THE REGULATIONS.
- 8 (4) THE REGULATIONS MAY AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT TO
- 9 PURCHASE OYSTERS AT MARKET PRICE FROM A PERSON WHO HAS A POWER DREDGE
- 10 LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION TO BE TRANSPLANTED FOR RESTORATION PURPOSES
- 11 TO THE OYSTER SANCTUARY DESCRIBED IN REGULATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH
- 12 PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 14 June 1, 1999.
