- 17 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, in Anne
- 18 Arundel County, Baltimore City, Baltimore County, Calvert County, Caroline County,
- 19 Carroll County, Cecil County, Charles County, Dorchester County, Frederick County,
- 20 Harford County, Howard County, Kent County, Prince George's County, Queen Anne's
- 21 County, St. Mary's County, Somerset County, Washington County, Wicomico County,
- 22 and Worcester County, the plaintiff or holder of a certificate of sale is not entitled to
- 23 be reimbursed for expenses incurred within [4] 6 months after the date of sale.
