- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Health General
- 16 24-212.
- 17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 18 INDICATED.
- 19 (2) "ANTISHOPLIFTING GATE" MEANS AN ACOUSTOMAGNETIC
- 20 ELECTRONIC ARTICLE SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM.
- 21 (3) "PUBLIC AREA" MEANS A ROOM OR A PORTION OF A ROOM OR OTHER
- 22 AREA TO WHICH THE PUBLIC HAS READY ACCESS.
- 23 (4) "RETAIL STORE" MEANS ANY ESTABLISHMENT WHOSE PRIMARY
- 24 PURPOSE IS TO SELL TO CONSUMERS ANY GOODS, WARES, FOOD FOR CONSUMPTION
- 25 OFF PREMISES, OR MERCHANDISE.
- 26 (B) A RETAIL STORE THAT USES AN ANTISHOPLIFTING GATE SHALL POST IN A
- 27 CONSPICUOUS PUBLIC AREA IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO THE ANTISHOPLIFTING GATE

- 1 SIGNS THAT CLEARLY INDICATE THAT THE ANTISHOPLIFTING GATE MAY INTERFERE
- 2 WITH THE OPERATION OF A CARDIAC PACEMAKER, DEFIBRILLATOR, OR SPINAL CORD
- 3 STIMULATOR.
- 4 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT
- 5 EXCEEDING \$100.
- 6 (D) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO ENFORCE THE
- 7 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 9 October 1, 1999.
