- 3 FOR the purpose of exempting certain persons that enter into certain agreements
- 4 regarding certain utility services with public institutions of higher education
- 5 from being considered public service companies subject to the jurisdiction of the

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 Article - Education 2 15-109.

- 3 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER
- 4 EDUCATION THAT OWNS, MANAGES, OR MAINTAINS A STEAM SYSTEM OR AN
- 5 ELECTRIC SYSTEM FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING SERVICES EXCLUSIVELY FOR
- 6 THE BENEFIT OF THE INSTITUTION.
- 7 (B) A PERSON THAT ENTERS INTO AN AGREEMENT OR LEASE WITH A PUBLIC
- 8 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO FACILITATE OR UNDERTAKE THE
- 9 FINANCING, WHOLE OR PARTIAL OWNERSHIP, OPERATION, GENERATION,
- 10 CONSTRUCTION, DISTRIBUTION, OR MAINTENANCE OF AN ON-SITE STEAM OR
- 11 ELECTRIC GENERATION, PRODUCTION, OR DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM FOR THE
- 12 INSTITUTION MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY, AS DEFINED
- 13 IN § 1-101 OF THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMPANIES ARTICLE, SUBJECT TO THE
- 14 JURISDICTION OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION AS A RESULT OF THE
- 15 FINANCING, LEASING, OWNERSHIP, OPERATION, CONTROL, MANAGEMENT,
- 16 CONSTRUCTION, DISTRIBUTION, OR MAINTENANCE OF THE STEAM OR ELECTRIC
- 17 SYSTEM.

- 20 (p) "Public service company" means a common carrier company, electric
- 21 company, gas company, sewage disposal company, steam heating company, telegraph
- 22 company, telephone company, water company, or any combination of public service
- 23 companies.

- 25 (a) To the full extent that the Constitution and laws of the United States
- 26 allow, the Commission has jurisdiction over each public service company that engages
- 27 in or operates a utility business in the State and over motor carrier companies as
- 28 provided in Title 9 of this article.
- 29 (b) (1) The Commission has the powers specifically conferred by law.
- 30 (2) The Commission has the implied and incidental powers needed or
- 31 proper to carry out its functions under this article.
- 32 (c) The powers of the Commission shall be construed liberally.
- 33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 34 July 1, 1999.
