- 11 applications must be submitted to the Board; requiring the payment of a certain
- 12 reinstatement fee for a pharmacy permit under certain circumstances; altering

- 15 certain manufacturing permit and distribution permit to expire at a certain time
- 16 without subsequent reinstatement under certain circumstances; altering and
- 17 adding certain definitions; and generally relating to the State Board of
- 18 Pharmacy and the practice of pharmacy.
