

CHAPTER
1 AN ACT concerning
2 Vehicle Laws - Speeding in a School Zone - Penalties
FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that warning lights must be in place and flashing in order for fines to be doubled for speeding in a school zone during certain hours; clarifying language establishing that fines for speeding in a school zone are doubled if a sign designating the school zone indicates that fines for speeding are doubled during school hours; repealing a limitation on a certain penalty for speeding within a school zone; and generally relating to fines for speeding in a school zone.
10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 11 Article - Transportation 12 Section 21-803.1 and 27-101(r) 13 Annotated Code of Maryland 14 (1998 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement) 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article - Transportation
18 21-803.1.
(a) (1) Subject to subsection (f) of this section, within a half-mile radius of any school, the State Highway Administration or a local authority:
21 (i) May establish a school zone and maximum speed limits 22 applicable in the school zone; and



- 1 per hour in the school zone during the hours posted on signs designating the school 2 zone.
- 3 27-101.
- 4 (r) Any person who is convicted of a violation of § 21-803.1(e) of this article
- 5 (Fines doubled for speeding within school zones) is subject to a fine of not more than
- 6 \$1,000 [if timed flashing warning lights were activated at the time of the violation,
- 7 indicating that doubled fines are in effect].
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 9 effect October 1, 1999.
