A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Election - Compensation of Election Judges - Baltimore County**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the compensation of election judges in Baltimore
4 County by a certain amount; providing that this Act does not apply to the salary
5 or compensation of the incumbent election judges in Baltimore County; and
6 generally relating to the compensation of election judges.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 33 - Election Code**

15 10-205.

16 (b) (3) In Baltimore County, the compensation for each election day actually
17 served shall be:

18 (i) [\$135] \$160 per day for each chief election judge; and

19 (ii) [\$100] \$125 per day for every other election judge.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
21 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
22 apply to the salary or compensation of the Baltimore County Election Judges in office
23 on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
24 compensation of the Baltimore County Election Judges shall take effect at the
25 beginning of the next following term of office.

26 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
27 July 1, 1999.
