16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 (d) (1) (i) A special Class C beer, wine and liquor license entitles the 21 holder to exercise any of the privileges conferred by this class of license for the use of

- 1 any person holding a bona fide entertainment conducted by a club, society, or
- 2 association at the place described for a period not exceeding seven consecutive days,
- 3 upon the payment of a fee of \$15 per day.
- 4 (ii) The provisions of § 11-517 of this article do not apply to holders
- 5 of this license. Alcoholic beverages sold under this special license shall be purchased
- 6 by such special license holder from retail dealers.
- 7 (6) In Carroll County the fee is [\$30] \$50 per day.
