- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- **Article State Government** 13
- 14 2-102.
- 15 The State shall provide the members of the General Assembly with [(a)]
- 16 reasonable office space and services, equipment, and secretarial services, as provided
- 17 in the State budget.
- 18 A municipal corporation, county, or other political subdivision or its [(b)](1)
- 19 governing body may not subsidize a member of the General Assembly in the
- 20 maintenance of the space, services, or equipment.
- This subsection does not prohibit the establishment of an office by a 21
- 22 political subdivision to maintain liaison between the subdivision and the General
- 23 Assembly.]
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 July 1, 1999.
