- 3 (a) The Department annually may issue a complimentary hunter's license to
- 4 the President of the United States, the governor of any state, any Maryland resident
- 5 who certifies that the resident is a former prisoner of war or 100% service connected
- 6 disabled American veteran, OR AN OFFICIAL OR AN ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF THE
- 7 GAME AND FISH MANAGEMENT AGENCY OF ANOTHER STATE WHICH RECIPROCALLY
- 8 OFFERS COMPLIMENTARY HUNTING LICENSES. A complimentary license is not
