Hunting - Complimentary Licenses

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to issue
4 annually a complimentary hunting license to an official or enforcement officer of
5 the game and fish management agency of another state under certain
6 circumstances; and generally relating to complimentary hunting licenses.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

3 (a) The Department annually may issue a complimentary hunter's license to
4 the President of the United States, the governor of any state, any Maryland resident
5 who certifies that the resident is a former prisoner of war or 100% service connected
6 disabled American veteran, OR AN OFFICIAL OR AN ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF THE
7 GAME AND FISH MANAGEMENT AGENCY OF ANOTHER STATE WHICH RECIPROCALLY
8 OFFERS COMPLIMENTARY HUNTING LICENSES. A complimentary license is not
9 transferable and shall be issued on forms designated by the Department.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 July 1, 1999.
