2 **Hunting - Complimentary Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to issue
4 annually a complimentary hunting license to an official or enforcement officer of
5 the game and fish management agency of another state; and generally relating
6 to complimentary hunting licenses.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Natural Resources**

15 10-303.

16 (a) The Department annually may issue a complimentary hunter's license to
17 the President of the United States, the governor of any state, any Maryland resident
18 who certifies that the resident is a former prisoner of war or 100% service connected
19 disabled American veteran, OR AN OFFICIAL OR AN ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF THE
20 GAME AND FISH MANAGEMENT AGENCY OF ANOTHER STATE. A complimentary
21 license is not transferable and shall be issued on forms designated by the
22 Department.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 July 1, 1999.
