- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 12 **Article 88B - Department of State Police**
- 13 9.
- 14 The Department shall collect, analyze, and disseminate information
- 15 relative to the incidence of crime within the State.
- 16 (b) The Department shall collect and analyze information relating to (1)
- 17 INCIDENTS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE WITHIN THE STATE AND incidents apparently
- 18 directed against an individual or group because of the individual's or the group's race,
- 19 religion, ethnicity, or sexual orientation.
- 20 Each local law enforcement agency and the State Fire Marshal shall
- 21 provide the Department the information described in paragraph (1) of this subsection.
- The Department shall adopt procedures for the collection and 22
- 23 analysis of information described in paragraph (1) of this subsection.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 October 1, 1999.
