A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Harford County - The Ripken Stadium

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$5,000,000,
- 4 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Mayor and City Council of the City of
- 5 Aberdeen for certain acquisition, development, or improvement purposes;
- 6 providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that
- 7 the County Executive and County Council of Harford County, the Mayor and
- 8 City Council of the City of Aberdeen, and the Maryland Baseball Limited
- 9 Partnership, respectively, shall each provide and expend a specified part of a
- matching fund; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds
- 11 evidencing the loan.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 13 MARYLAND, That:
- 14 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 15 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Harford
- 16 County The Ripken Stadium Loan of 1999 in a total principal amount equal to the
- 17 lesser of (i) \$5,000,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance
- 18 with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and
- 19 delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of
- 20 Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through
- 21 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 22 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 23 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 24 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 25 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 26 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 27 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 28 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 29 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 30 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Mayor and City Council of the City of
- 31 Aberdeen for the acquisition, planning, design, conversion, repair, renovation,
- 32 rehabilitation, restoration, reconstruction, construction, and capital equipping of The

- 1 Ripken Stadium, to be named in honor of the Ripken family, to commemorate the
- 2 impact the Ripken family has had on the game of baseball, and to provide recreational
- 3 opportunities for the citizens of Harford County.
- 4 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 5 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 6 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 7 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 8 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- $9\,$ purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the County Executive and County Council of
- 10 Harford County shall provide and expend a matching fund of up to \$2,000,000, the
- 11 Mayor and City Council of the City of Aberdeen shall provide and expend a matching
- 12 fund of up to \$2,000,000, and the Maryland Baseball Limited Partnership shall
- 13 provide and expend a matching fund of up to \$1,000,000. No part of the matching
- 14 fund may be provided, either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether
- 15 appropriated or unappropriated. The fund may consist of real property, in kind
- 16 contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any
- 17 dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify
- 18 as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the
- 19 Board's decision is final. The County Executive and County Council of Harford
- 20 County, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Aberdeen, and the Maryland
- 21 Baseball Limited Partnership, respectively, have until June 1, 2001, to present
- 22 evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that each of the entities will
- 23 provide a matching fund as specified. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board
- 24 shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and
- 25 the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended
- 26 for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount
- 27 of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be
- 28 of no further effect.
- 29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 June 1, 1999.
