House Bill 10 (Delegate Kopp. *et al.*)

Ways & Means

Commission on Education Finance, Equity, and Excellence

This bill establishes a 27-member Commission on Education Finance, Equity, and Excellence. The commission must review existing education financing formulas and accountability measures. The commission's interim findings and recommendations are due to the Governor and the General Assembly by January 1, 2000. A final report is due by October 15, 2000. The State Board of Education and the Department of Legislative Services are required to provide staff support.

This bill takes effect June 1, 1999.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Staffing costs for the State Board of Education and the Department of Legislative Services are assumed to be minimal and absorbable within existing budgeted resources.
