Economic Matters

Anne Arundel County - Task Force on Multiple Alcoholic Beverages Licensing

This bill establishes an 11-member Task Force on Multiple Alcoholic Beverages Licensing in Anne Arundel County. The task force is required to study how independent restaurant operators as well as restaurant franchises can be provided the same opportunity to hold an interest in more than one alcoholic beverages license in the county. Staff support for the task force will be provided by the Department of Legislative Services. The task force must report its findings and recommendations by December 31, 1999.

This bill takes effect June 1, 1999 and terminates December 31, 1999.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Minimal. Any costs associated with expense reimbursements for task force members could be handled with existing resources. Staff assistance could be provided with existing personnel. No effect on revenues.
