### **FISCAL NOTE**

House Bill 200 (St. Marv's County Delegation) Economic Matters

#### St. Mary's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Disciplinary Proceedings Against Licensees

This bill authorizes the Alcoholic Beverages Board of St. Mary's County to proceed administratively against a licensee who was granted probation before judgment for a violation of alcoholic beverage laws regarding the selling of alcoholic beverages to a minor or an intoxicated person. The board may also act administratively against an employee of a licensee for these violations. Current law provides that if a licensee or employee of a licensee is placed on probation without a verdict for these violations, the liquor control board may not bring any administrative proceedings.

#### **Fiscal Summary**

**Local Effect:** Any fines or suspensions imposed pursuant to this bill would be minimal. No effect on expenditures.
