Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages
(24th District - Limited Hours)
PG 300-99

This bill limits the hours of off-sale liquor in the 24th alcoholic beverages district to 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. The Prince George's County Board of License Commissioners could monitor licensees with existing resources.

Small Business Effect: Potential minimal impact. Currently, licensees may sell off-premises alcohol from 6:00 a.m. until 2:00 a.m. There are 68 licensees in the 24th district, of which a significant number are small businesses. To the extent that these establishments sell off-premises alcohol before 10:00 a.m. and after 1:00 a.m., there could be a negative impact on these licensees.
