FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 940 (Delegate Donoghue)

Economic Matters

Maryland Apprenticeship and Training Council - Membership

This bill alters the representation of the 12-member Maryland Apprenticeship and Training Council, and provides term limits for its members.

The bill requires the council to include two representatives from training programs approved by the council, and eliminates one representative of employee organizations and one representative of employers. As a result, the council would include:

- 4 representatives of employers;
- 3 representatives of employee organizations;
- 2 representatives from training programs approved by the council;
- 2 representatives of the general public; and
- 1 representative of employees.

The bill also requires the council to include:

- 2 members from the Baltimore metropolitan region;
- 2 members from the suburban Washington region;
- 2 members from the western Maryland region;
- 2 members from the southern Maryland region; and
- 2 members residing in the State at large.

The bill prohibits a member from serving more than two terms; and a member who is appointed to fill a vacancy prior to the expiration of a term shall be appointed to serve for the remainder of that term.

State Effect: None. Altering the composition of the council and providing term limits for council members would not affect State finances.

Local Effect: None.
