Family Law - Permanency Plan Hearing for Out-of-Home Placement - Opportunity to Speak

This bill authorizes an attorney for a foster parent, preadoptive parent, or relative providing care for a child in an out-of-home placement the opportunity to speak at the permanency plan hearing for out-of-home placement. It requires a local department of social services to provide notice of a permanency plan hearing for out-of-home placement to an attorney for a foster parent, preadoptive parent, or relative providing care for a child in an out-of-home placement.
