House Bill 631 (Montgomery County and Prince George's County Delegations)
Commerce and Government Matters

Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission - District Council for Montgomery County - Campaign Contributions by Applicants - Final Action on Applicants' Project MC/PG 5-99

This bill prohibits an individual or business from requesting final action on an application relating to development, improvement, or construction on land within the Maryland-Washington Metropolitan District if within the preceding 24 months the individual or business has made a contribution to the County Executive of Montgomery County or to a member of the County Council of Montgomery County. Under current law an applicant must file a statement that discloses any contributions made to a candidate during the four-year election cycle before filing the application.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** Prohibiting an applicant from requesting final action on an application if the applicant made a contribution to a member of the county council or the county executive would not materially affect local revenues or expenditures.
