## FISCAL NOTE Bond Bill

House Bill 1101 (Delegate Redmer. et al.)

**Appropriations** 

Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City - Police Department - Purchase of Cars

This bill provides \$2.4 million as a grant to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for the purchase of police cars.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** This \$2.4 million grant would be part of the total \$445 million general obligation debt authorization for FY 2000 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability committee. State debt service costs on the \$445 million would be a maximum of \$45.3 million annually based on the 4.26% interest rate realized at the February 24, 1999 bond sale.

**Local Effect:** City of Baltimore grant revenue and expenditures would increase by \$2.4 million.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal.
