House Bill 252 (Allegany County Delegation)

Economic Matters

Allegany County - Alcoholic Beverages - Disposition of License Fees

This bill provides that the Director of Finance of Allegany County is required to credit to the county 5% of the alcoholic beverage license fees received for licenses that are issued to businesses within a municipal corporation to cover administrative costs. The remainder of the revenue is to be divided equally between the county and municipality.
