FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 742 (Delegate Menes)

Economic Matters

Alcoholic Beverages - Delivery to University or College Campus

This bill prohibits an off-sale retail alcoholic beverages licensee from delivering alcoholic beverages to a dormitory, a fraternity or sorority house, or any other residence located at a university or college campus if the location can be reasonably believed to be accessible to a person under the age of 21. The prohibition does not apply to delivery to administrators or faculty, official functions, or catered events.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Local boards of license commissioners or alcoholic beverages boards could monitor licensees with existing resources. No effect on revenues.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
