Commerce and Government Matters

Vehicle Laws - Driving in the Left Lane - Restrictions

The bill prohibits a vehicle from driving in the far left lane on a roadway that has two or more lanes for traffic moving in the same direction unless the vehicle is overtaking another vehicle.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Indeterminate general fund revenue increase from the penalty provision applicable to this offense under the Maryland Vehicle Law (maximum \$500 fine). Any increase is assumed to be minimal. Enforcement could be handled with existing resources.
