Environmental Matters

State Board of Cosmetologists - Powers - Prohibition of Equipment, Substances, and Products

This bill authorizes the State Board of Cosmetologists to prohibit or restrict the use of lasers in beauty salons.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Potential minimal. If the State Board of Cosmetologists exercises the authority provided by the bill to prohibit the use of lasers in beauty salons, general fund expenditures could increase slightly to conduct inspections and hold hearings.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
