Appropriations

State Personnel - Probation - Scope of Coverage

This departmental bill eliminates the requirement that an employee in the management service or in a special appointment position in the State Personnel Management System serve a probationary period.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Because management service and special appointment employees may be terminated at will, elimination of the probationary period requirement would not affect State personnel expenditures.

Local Effect: None.
