**Drivers' Licenses - Refusal to License**

---

This bill requires the Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) to refuse to license for a two-year period any individual convicted of manslaughter by automobile or vessel or homicide by motor vehicle while intoxicated. If the individual is imprisoned due to the conviction, the refusal period must begin after the individual has completed the sentence.
