House Bill 343 (Prince George's County Delegation)

Wavs and Means

Prince George's County - Transfer Tax PG 420-99

This bill reduces Prince George's County's maximum transfer tax rate from 1.4% to 1.0%. The bill is effective July 1, 1999.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. This bill does not affect the State transfer tax rate.

Local Effect: Significant decrease in county revenues. Based on FY 1999 data, county revenues could decrease by \$12.5 million in FY 2000. No effect on expenditures.

Small Business Effect: Potential minimal. A decrease in transfer taxes would reduce the cost of acquiring property for small businesses.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Revenues: Prince George's County expects revenues of \$43.8 million in fiscal 1999 from the current 1.4% transfer tax rate. Based on fiscal 1999 data, reducing the rate to 1% would result in a \$12.5 million revenue loss (28.6%) in fiscal 2000. However, the actual decrease in fiscal 2000 could vary because transfer tax revenues tend to fluctuate based on factors such as mortgage rates and general economic conditions.
