Judiciary

Crimes - Escape Revision

This bill revises and restates the laws relating to escape, contraband, temporary release, and home detention in Article 27 of the Annotated Code - Crimes and Punishments. The bill clarifies felony escape provisions relating to local jails.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Minimal. Although some of the revisions to escape provisions are substantive, these changes are not expected to measurably affect State correctional operations or finances.

Local Effect: Minimal. Although some of the revisions to escape provisions are substantive, these changes are not expected to measurably affect local detention facility operations or finances.

Small Business Effect: None.
