Economic Matters

Worcester County - Alcoholic Beverages - Special Sunday Club Licenses

This bill increases from 8 to 20 the number of Special Sunday Club Licenses that may be issued in Worcester County each year to a bona fide club that already holds a Class C license.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Minimal revenue increase. No effect on expenditures.

Small Business Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Effect: Under current law, Worcester County is authorized to adjust alcoholic beverages licensing fees. The actual fee for a special Sunday club license is \$50, not \$10 as specified under current law. There are two bona fide clubs with Class C licenses that would be eligible for additional special Sunday licenses. Assuming both clubs apply for an additional 12 licenses, county revenues would increase by approximately \$1,200 annually.
