FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 823 (Prince George's County Delegation)

Economic Matters

Prince George's County - Board of License Commissioners - Salaries
PG 304-99

This bill increases the annual salary of (1) members of the Board of License Commissioners for Prince George's County from \$17,000 to \$18,530; (2) the chairman of the board from \$18,000 to \$19,620; (3) the administrator from \$40,705 to \$44,369; and (4) the attorney for the board from \$15,500 to \$16,895. In addition, the minimum annual salary for an inspector increases from \$9,270 to \$10,104. The bill is effective July 1, 1999.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Prince George's County expenditures would increase by \$40,106 in FY 2000 and thereafter. No effect on revenues.

Small Business Effect: None.
